The National flag is a horizontal tricolour of deep saffron (kesaria) at the top, white in the middle and dark green at the bottom in equal proportion. In the centre of the white band is a navy-blue wheel which represents the chakra. The top saffron colour, indicates the strength and courage of the country. The white middle band indicates peace and truth with Dharma Chakra. The green shows the fertility, growth and auspiciousness of the land. The chakra has 24 spokes that depicts that there is life in movement and death in stagnation. The design of the National Flag was adopted by the Constituent Assembly of India on 22 July 1947.



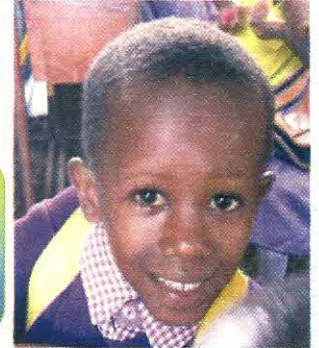
